## FLAGSTAFF UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT OVERRIDE



An **Override** is an increase by an additional 15% of the annual Maintenance and Operations allocation. The FUSD Governing Board has called for a continuation of the current override.

*NO INCREASE to homeowners' current tax rate of \$55 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation.*

### THE 2022 OVERRIDE RENEWAL WILL BE USED TO MAINTAIN AND ENHANCE:

- Current class sizes with an emphasis at the primary grades
- Full-day Kindergarten (currently funded by State for 1/2 day)
- Athletics and the arts
- Extra-curricular activities and programs
- Art, Music, and Physical Education in elementary schools
- Gifted Education, Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and STEM programs
- Preschool programs
- Compliance with State mandates
- All other current programs and services to the extent possible



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## FLAGSTAFF UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND



A **Bond** supports funding for construction, facilities, technology, and buses. The FUSD Governing Board has called for authorization of a \$100 million bond.

**\$100 MILLION BOND =**

**\$0.35 PER MONTH**  
property tax increase per  
\$100,000 of assessed value

### PRIORITIZED PROJECTS FOR THE 2022 BOND MAY INCLUDE:

- \$25 million** - Replacement/Rebuild, and possible relocation, of Kinsey Elementary
- \$25 million** - Replacement/Rebuild, and possible relocation, of Marshall Elementary
- \$12 million** - Replacement/Rebuild of Transportation and Maintenance Facilities
- \$12 million** - Major maintenance life cycle projects
- \$5 million** - Camp Colton Master Plan improvements
- \$6 million** - Campus-specific projects
- \$7 million** - Bus/Transportation fleet replacement
- \$8 million** - Technology replacements and upgrades
