

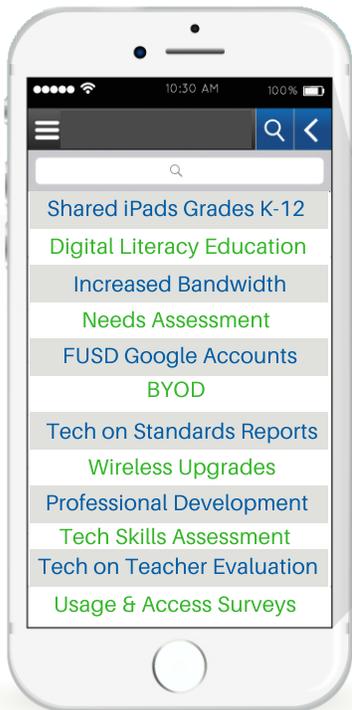


2018 Bond Technology Information

1:1 Device Readiness Completed Projects



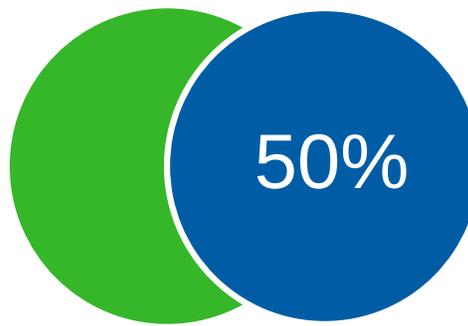
