Unallowable **Expenses:**

Non-school related recreational activities, girls/boys scout, invitation cards, receptions and banquets for extra-curriculum activities, student insurance, past dues and fees, athletic apparel, personal clothing, activity cards, yearbooks, school pictures, prom expenses, medical and/or legal expenses.

Payments cannot be made directly to individuals and cannot be reimbursed to individuals who have made payments out of pocket. Request may take 2-4 weeks to process.
